What is the pre-session?

The pre-session is an opportunity for any member of the NSW NSAA to present a short speech (ideally part of a larger presentation they are working on) or a pitch, with a view to receiving constructive feedback from experienced NSAA members. The new format is designed to maximise participation and it is also a great way for more members to get to know each other – and help each other.

When does it take place?

The pre-session begins at 5.15pm (please arrive by 5pm if you are a speaker) and runs until dinner at 6pm before each chapter meeting.

What is the format of the pre-session?

There will be two speakers (5 mins each) and two pitches (3 mins each.) All four slots will have 3 mins allocated for feedback. After the speakers, there will be a 10 minute forum discussion, led by the pre-session MC. A specific question will be addressed and general participation is invited. An example of a forum question: “What is the best marketing strategy you’ve ever used?”

How do I get on the pre-session program?

Contact Dale or Kevin and indicated which month you’d like to speak.

What do I do once my slot has been confirmed on the pre-session program?

You will receive an email asking for the following:

- A three-line introduction, including a title or topic sentence to the MC for the pre-session
- You may like to provide a context for your speech / pitch in that introduction.
- Please be aware that timing is important so as to allow maximum participation. Timing cards will be used.
